


## Correct account numbers essential for tax refunds

Do you provide your Interra Credit Union account number for direct deposit of your income tax refunds? To ensure a timely deposit of your money, it's essential that you provide your account numbers in an accurate form.

The IRS no longer attaches Social Security numbers or other tax identification to tax refund direct deposits. Unfortunately direct deposits must be returned if credit union personnel are not able to identify the recipient account. That will result in delays, as the IRS will then issue and mail a paper check.

### ***Deposit to your checking account.***

- The "routing number" is the nine-digit number found in the lower left-hand corner of your check, **271291017**.
- Your "account number" is the next set of ten numbers on the bottom of your check and should be provided exactly as it appears on your check.
