

Hometown Giving – a huge success!

Thank you, Interra Credit Union members, for helping to make the “Hometown Giving...Now more than Ever” holiday service project so successful.

We were able to raise more than \$26,000 to help agencies who help those in need, now more than ever.

- Members donated almost \$4,700. As you may recall, the credit union committed to a “match” of up to \$2,500, which was achieved.
- The Interra staff donated more than \$4,000, through a variety of initiatives and events, including dress down days, a Chinese auction, a staff silent auction and other fundraising events.
- Interra Credit Union donated an additional \$15,000.

Thank you, too, to the literally hundreds of gifts brought into the credit union through the “angel tree” donations. For example, of the 83 items that were needed for the Salvation Army adopt-a-family commitment, 53 items, or 64%, came from those donations.

Another member brought in four hand-crafted doll cradles, sure to delight the lucky little girls who received them.
