The 4,900 square foot full-service office includes a drive-thru, increased lobby space, a night depository, ATM, and local lending for consumers, mortgage, agribusiness, and commercial needs. Lori Bolyard, Mortgage Loan Advisor, and Clayton Sheets, Agribusiness Lender, continue assisting members with their lending needs.
