

Security Statement

Interra Credit Union is committed to the security of your financial and personal information. Our computer systems and online banking site are secured by firewalls, passwords and encryptions. We maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safe guards that comply with federal regulations to guard your nonpublic personal information. Keep in mind, however, that no system is foolproof. To further protect the security of your information:

- Routinely review and reconcile your account statements.
- Keep information with us current. It is important that we have current information on how to reach you. If we detect potentially fraudulent or unauthorized activity or use of an account, we will attempt to contact you immediately. If your address or phone number changes, please let us know.
- If you become aware of incorrect information either in our records or as reported by us, please notify us in writing at Interra Credit Union, P.O. Box 727, Goshen, IN 46527-0727, or via e-mail at msg@interracu.com and we will make the necessary corrections promptly.
- Protect your account records, passwords, logon identification and other information pertaining to your relationship with us.
- NEVER reveal your access codes, passwords or personal identification numbers to anyone - ever! Attempts to break these passwords are monitored by special software, which will only allow a few attempts before the password needs to be reset personally in one of our branches. If you think any of your passwords have been compromised, change them immediately!
- Do not leave your computer while you are in the midst of an online session or transaction.
- When you are finished using any of our online services, be sure to log off the system before visiting other websites.
- If other people have access to your computer, clear your browser's cache in order to remove copies of web pages that may have been stored temporarily on your system.
